## **Construction site on U6 subway line: Replacement busses to provide service to MOC Veranstaltungscener München**

- **Subway closed between “Kieferngarten” and “Studentenstadt” stations from May 21 to August 25, 2013**
- **Replacement busses to provide service on normal U6 route**

After 40 years of service, the rails between the “Kieferngarten” and “Studentenstadt” subway stations must be completely replaced. That is why the entire section of the U6 subway line will be closed from May 23 – August 25, 2013. U6 trains coming from “Garching-Forschungszentrum” will provide service as far as “Kieferngarten”, and trains coming from “Klinikum Großhadern” will provide service as far as the “Studentenstadt” subway station. As a result, guests travelling from the city to the MOC Veranstaltungscener München won’t be able to reach “Kieferngarten”, which is the nearest subway station. During this period, replacement busses will provide service between the “Studentenstadt” and “Kieferngarten” stations. Depending on the time of day, as many as 26 busses will provide replacement service and keep restrictions to a minimum.

During construction, Münchner Verkehrsgesellschaft will inform passengers using announcements, displays and signs in the respective subway stations and ask them to allow for longer travel times. While the tracks are being replaced, “Kieferngarten” station will be upgraded and made handicap accessible. Additional construction is planned for approximately the same period of time in 2014.
